






Al-beruni - Tahqiq - I - Hind

During the reign of Muhammad-bin-Tughlag.


Book 'Rehla' - Light on the reign of Muhammad-bin-Tughlaq

An ambassador of selecus Nikator, who visited the court of Chandragupta Maurya.


He wrote an interesting book 'Indica' in which he gave a vivid account of chandragupta maurya 's Regin.

Hiuen-Tsang (630-645AD)


Reign of Harshavardhana

Work 'Muruj-ul-zahab'.



William Hawkins (1608-1611AD)



Nicolo Conti (1395 AD – 1469 AD)


Italian traveller and a merchant who visited India in 1420 AD at the Vijayanagara empire probably after the accession of Deva Raya II
